Emily Kroll, designed the new line with features such as the Modular Box Sectional, that can be re-arranged for your own personal preference. Each sofa is made from FSC-certified alder wood and eco-fabrics such as tencel. Pure rubber with no chemical additives is used for the cushions and no chemical flame-retardants are used.
